1. FUNCTION OVERVIEW


The following parts accompany the patio heater: A bag of accessories with 6x M5 X 10 screws and 4x M6 X 30 screws

Operation:

You can turn the heater on and off by pulling the cord (5). Any gentle vibrations that occur when you turn on the heater will stop within a few seconds.

-Position 0: OFF

-Position 1: 650W (normal power)-Position 2: 1,300W (normal power)-Position 3: 2,000W (full power)





The quartz radiant heater is also equipped with a safeguard device, which turns the heater off if it is knocked over.


2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Read all instructions before using this heater.
- 2) Never touch the heater when in operation (risk of burns).
- 3) Never touch the heater with wet hands.
- 4) Never place anything on the heater's hot surfaces as this may cause overheating (e.g. towels)
 - -After use
 - -In the event of malfunction
 - -Before cleaning it.
- 5) WARNING: Ensure the heater is not located directly below a mains power socket outlet
- 6) Do not use the heater with a programmer, timer or any other device that switch the heater on automatically.
- 7) Do not use this heater in the immediate surrounding of a bath, a shower or swimming pool.
- 8) If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacture or its service agent or a fully qualified electrician in order to avoid a hazard.

3. INSTALLATION








Insert the lower post assembly (11) Into the foot plate/base (15) and secure it using 4x M6 X 30 screws (fig.1)

Secure that the lower post assembly (11) and the middle post (9) using 3 x M5 X 10 screws

Secure the upper post assembly (7) and the middle post (9) using 3x M5 X 10 screws (fig.3) (fig.2)



Attach the heating element (1) to the upper post assembly (7) and secure it by tightening the button (fig.4)
